IDOC's INSOMM Program Earns "PROGRAM OF THE YEAR"

Our statewide program in Indiana has helped to protect the public by maintaining one of the lowest rates of recidivism in the country for well over a decade. In fact, the Indiana Department of Correction (IDOC) SOMM program was awarded the 2014 "Program of the Year" by the Indiana Criminal Justice Association. As can be noted in our graph to the right, only 1.29% of INSOMM sex offenders released to parole in 2010 committed a new sex crime within 3 years of release.

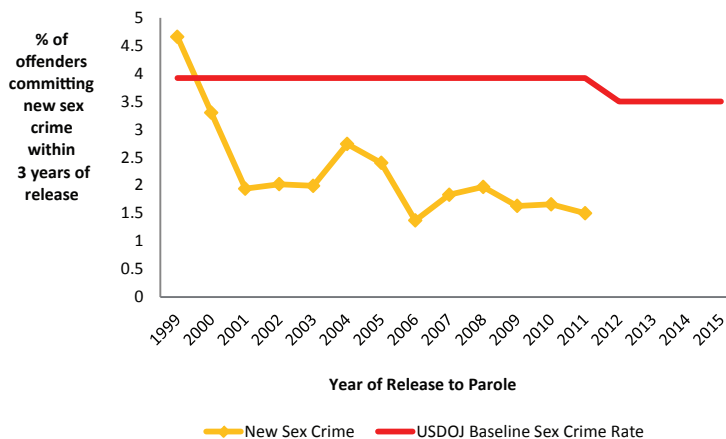
